She was the former Democratic State Senator (1993–2009) and State Legislator (1987–1993) for the 40th Washington Legislative

District. When Harriet died, in February 2016, she was serving as the Sehome Neighborhood President. Harriet is remembered for her activism against nuclear power plants and in favor of environmental protections. She championed many programs that benefitted women and children as well as all citizens of Washington state.

# Report from York's June 14 general meeting

Guest speaker Chris Comeau, City Transportation Planner, presented the preliminary findings of the Samish Way—Maple Street traffic study. Originally, the transportation redevelopment plan for this corridor was based on the Samish Urban Village ideas; but with the new development to be built at the former Aloha Motel site, revisions to the plan will be necessary to accommodate more residential traffic at this location.

Comeau also reported that in September 2018 a new Red "HAWK" (High-intensity Activated crossWalK) crosswalk will be installed on Lakeway Drive at Grant Street, much improving the safety of this crossing. The equipment currently at Grant Street will be moved to the Maple Street crosswalk by Pizza Pipeline. Good news for improved pedestrian safety!
